**JOB GOAL:** To develop in each pupil understanding of relationship of good body function and exercise; to motivate each pupil to cultivate physical fitness, hygienic habits and good social and emotional adjustment; to discover and develop talents of pupils in physical achievement; to develop strength, skill, agility, poise and coordination in individual, dual and team physical activities and sports in accordance with each pupil's ability

**PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Teaches skills in physical fitness, health education, rhythms and dance , and individual, dual or team sports, utilizing course of study adopted by Board of Education and other appropriate learning activities
2. Analyzes, demonstrates and explains basic skills, knowledge and strategies of formal sports, games, rhythms and fundamentals of body movement
3. May teach physical education classes for interscholastic athletics
4. Provides appropriate safety instruction and makes safety checks on equipment and field areas to ensure overall safety of pupils
5. Maintains control of storage and use of school owned property
6. Establishes and maintains standards of pupil behavior needed to provide an orderly, productive environment in physical education areas
7. Evaluates each pupil's growth in physical skills, knowledge and contribution in team sports
8. Maintains professional competence through inservice education provided by District and/or in self-selected professional growth activities
9. Selects and requisitions uniforms, equipment and instructional aids; maintains required inventory records
10. Communicates with parents, teachers and magnet coordinator on pupil progress
11. Identifies pupil needs and cooperates with other professional staff members in helping pupils solve health, attitude and learning problems
12. Cooperates with school administration in providing specialty performing groups for special occasions, PTA meetings, assemblies and interscholastic athletic events
13. Supervises pupils in out-of-classroom activities during assigned working day; provides noontime activities of organized sports
14. Participates in curriculum and other developmental programs
15. Participates in faculty committees and sponsorship of student activities
