JOB GOAL: To develop in each pupil interest in and ability for expressing himself/herself creatively in visual terms, utilizing skills and techniques of artistic expression appropriate to pupil's interests and abilities; to develop aesthetic understandings and appreciations; to discover and develop talents of pupils in field of art

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Teaches skills in art, including crafts, drawing, painting, lettering, design, commercial art, art history and three-dimensional art to K-6 pupils following course of study adopted by Board of Education and other appropriate learning activities
2. Provides instruction by which pupils develop aesthetic concepts and appreciations and ability to make qualitative judgments about art
3. Develops instructional plans and organizes class time to provide balanced program of art instruction, demonstration and working time
4. Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to needs of pupils with varying intellectual and artistic abilities and to accommodate variety of instructional activities
5. Establishes and maintains standards of pupil behavior needed to provide orderly and productive environment
6. Instructs pupils in proper care and use of tools and equipment
7. Organizes storage areas and controls use of materials, equipment and tools to prevent loss or abuse and to minimize time required for distribution and collection
8. Evaluates each pupil's performance and growth in knowledge and aesthetic understandings and prepares progress reports
9. Selects and requisitions books, instructional materials, tools, instructional aides and maintains inventory records
10. Plans and presents art displays and exhibitions designed to exhibit pupils' work for school and community
11. Maintains professional competence through inservice education activities provided by District and/or in self-selected professional growth activities
12. Maintains auditable record of pupil attendance and makes daily reports of pupils absent each period
13. Communicates with parents, teachers and magnet teacher coordinator on pupil progress
14. Participates in curriculum and other developmental programs within school of assignment or on District level

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: Salary and work year to be according to current schedule; teacher salary schedule

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with the District's "Improvement of Professional Services" handbook, Board Policies and Procedures and consistent with collective bargaining agreements when applicable
