QUALIFICATIONS: California teaching credential authorizing service to physically handicapped students

REPORTS TO: Principal

JOB GOAL: To provide each physically handicapped student with program that will enable him to reach his fullest developmental, behavioral, and academic potential

PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. In cooperation with principal and other staff members, plans and implements program of instruction consistent with District's course of study and student's individualized educational program
2. Creates classroom environment conducive to effective learning and behavioral control, and which allows each student opportunity to grow to his maximum potential
3. Evaluates each student's learning needs and plans and provides individualized instruction to meet specific needs
4. Participates in initial placement, review and annual evaluation meetings as required
5. Maintains accurate and complete records as determined by law and District policy
6. Coordinates efforts of professional staff to integrate students into regular program
7. Carries out assigned supervision duties outside of classroom as teacher of regular students is required
8. Participates in staff development activities as required
9. Communicates pupil progress with parents and maintains effective school-community relations

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: Salary and work year to be according to current schedule; teacher salary schedule

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with the District's "Improvement of Professional Services" handbook, Board Policies and Procedures and consistent with collective bargaining agreements when applicable
