

TITLE: TEACHER, INFANT DEVELOPMENT

QUALIFICATIONS: California special education teaching credential

REPORTS TO: Principal

SUPERVISES: Infant Technicians

FUNCTION: To provide developmental intervention activities for children birth to three years for problems that impede learning and further development

RESPONSIBILITY:

1. Assesses infants and prescribes individual intervention program
2. Trains infant technicians and supervises interaction with child and parent in home and classroom settings
3. Trains parents in child development and intervention activities through home visitations, participation at school and parent education meetings
4. Counsels parents in areas such as expectation of child development, parent and child interaction and sibling interaction
5. Attends eligibility and planning meetings
6. Prepares children for entry into appropriate educational placement upon transition from program

AUTHORITY:

1. Screens and places children in appropriate program
2. Develops and directs staff development
3. Develops and conducts parent inservice and counseling sessions
4. Participates in eligibility and planning meetings
5. Coordinates articulation between program and other District programs

TERMS OF EMPLOYMENT: Salary and work year to be according to current schedule; teacher salary schedule

EVALUATION: Performance of this job will be evaluated in accordance with the District's "Improvement of Professional Services" handbook, Board Policies and Procedures and consistent with collective bargaining agreements when applicable
