**JOB GOAL:** To develop in each pupil appreciation of art of music as part of general culture; to teach techniques of vocal and/or instrumental music expression; to discover and develop talents of pupils in fields of music; to develop knowledge and skills in listening and reading music; to meet goals established in District's "Purposes of Instruction", Course of Study and Curriculum Guide in relationship to specific needs of all students under his/her direction

**PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:**

1. Teaches skills in instrumental and vocal music to K-6 magnet students following course of study adopted by Board of Education and other appropriate learning activities
2. Provides instruction by which pupils develop aesthetic concepts and appreciation and ability to make qualitative judgments about music
3. Develops instructional plans and organizes class time to provide balanced program of music instruction, demonstration and practice time
4. Provides individual and small group instruction in order to adapt curriculum to needs of pupils with varying intellectual and musical abilities and to accommodate variety of instructional activities
5. Establishes and maintains standards of pupil behavior needed to provide orderly and productive environment
6. Instructs pupils in proper care and use of musical instruments
7. Organizes storage area and controls use of materials, equipment and instruments to prevent loss or abuse and to minimize time required for distribution and collection
8. Evaluates each pupil's performance and growth in musical knowledge and understanding and prepares progress reports
9. Selects and requisitions books, instructional materials, instruments, instructional aids and maintains inventory records
10. Plans, rehearses and directs pupils in musical programs for school and community
11. Maintains professional competence through inservice education activities provided by District and/or in self-selected professional growth activities
12. Maintains auditable records of pupil attendance and makes daily reports of pupils absent each period
13. Communicates with parents, teachers and magnet teacher coordinator on pupil progress
14. Participates in curriculum and other developmental programs within school of assignment or on District level
15. Performs other related duties as assigned
