PERFORMANCE RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Works closely with classroom teachers and program specialists in identifying children's disabilities and provides students appropriate learning experience
2. Works in classroom with groups of children in reading-listening center or classrooms
3. Works with small groups of children who have similar reading problems to motivate and encourage sustained effort in classroom
4. Identifies individual needs and works with pupils, teachers, support staff and parents in social, personal and academic adjustments of students; implements effective home-school relations
5. Provides wide variety of instructional resources related to children's needs
6. Develops and maintains system of recordkeeping
7. Disseminates current reading research
8. Assists in testing program
9. Communicates with parents, teachers and magnet coordinator on pupil progress during extended day
10. Maintains professional competence through inservice education activities provided by the District and self selected professional growth activities
11. Performs other related duties as assigned
